#### **Marita's Iris Season Timing**

You are invited to visit Marita's Iris Gardens.

This year they are starting later than usual because of the cooler weather earlier.

As of today, May 31, they are just beginning to open. I'm predicting that the best viewing time with the most to see will be June 6 - 16.

But perhaps there will still be some beyond that date too. Since we dug up and re-did ALL of our 200 iris clumps last summer, and made 2 additional beds, the number of blooms we are getting this year is much smaller, but still enough to enjoy a viewing.

I have to heed my own advice when I share irises, ... that they might not bloom the first year and I have to be patient for the second year. I only have 57 colors and 86 bud stalks showing. Usually I have over 100 colors and 200 bud stalks.

My other gardens are enjoyable to visit too, as well as to walk the iris maze in the moss.

My huge rhododendrons look like they will provide bright snowballs of color.
